

Sharks & Minnows

Mark a large square with cones.

All players “Minnows” have a ball and stand on one side of the large square. The coaches “Sharks” stand on the other side of the square. The coach says: “Fishies, Fishies, one, two, three. Fishies, Fishies come to me!”

Now the players aim to dribble their soccer balls to the other side without getting caught by the shark (coach). The coach should allow all players to get to the other side first time around. After this, it is at the coaches discretion how many fish they catch every round. At the beginning of each round the song can be sung again. Once a player has been caught they become a shark too. Last player to be tagged wins.
